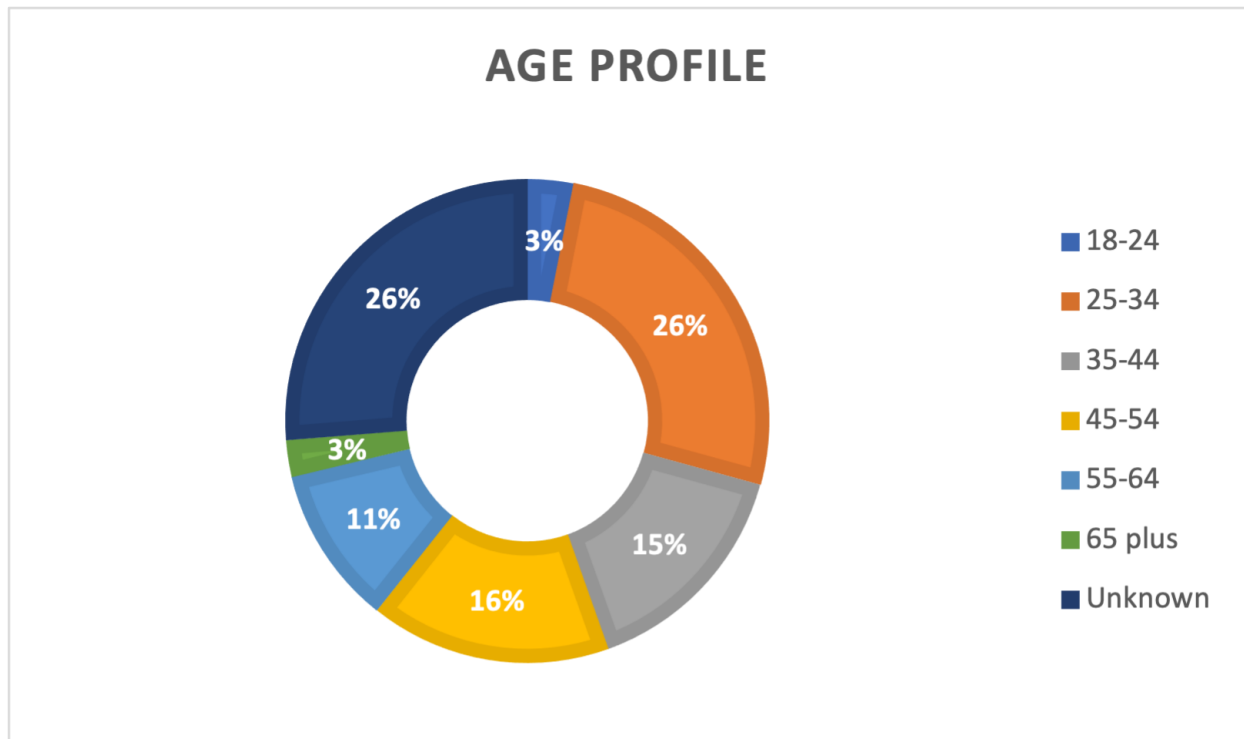

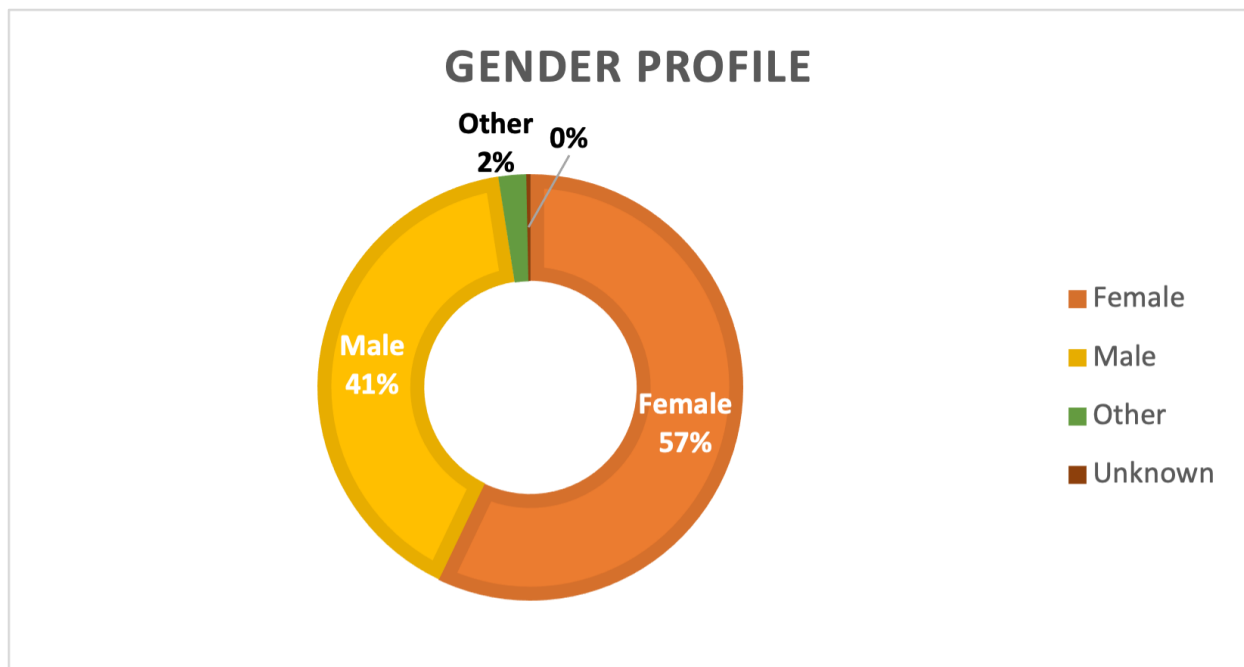

## Age profile

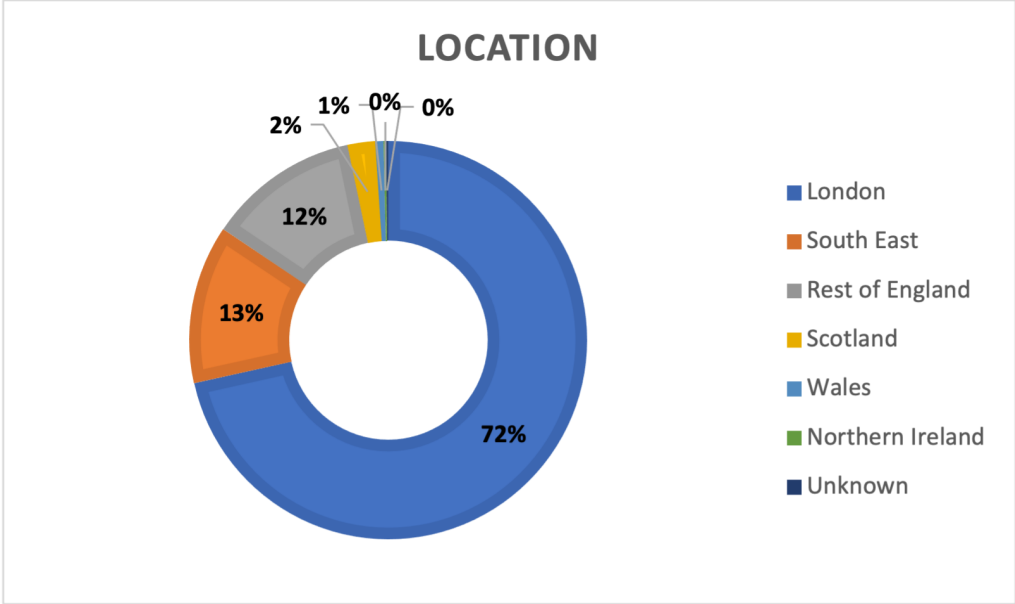


## Gender
